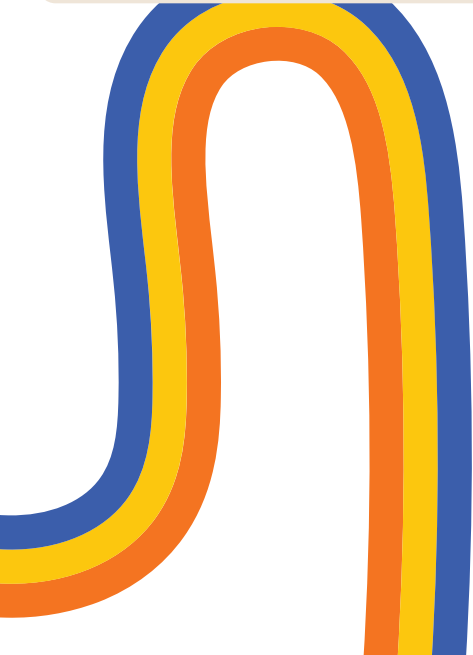
This session provides realistic do-able practices to enable you to address the diverse needs of gifted students in face-to-face classrooms.
